- Producing a variety of publications for students, policy-makers and higher education professionals.



Today: Multiple purposes of Higher Education

- Preparation for sustainable employment
- Preparation for life as active citizens in democratic societies
- Personal development
- Development and maintenance of a broad, advanced knowledge base



THREE DISTINCT MODES

- Personal: students' solitary actions that can be directed at changing their own circumstances or also those of others
- **Proxy:** trust to student representatives or student government to act on their behalf to **solve** a particular problem or secure a particular outcome

 Collective: belief in their collective efficacy as a group to secure a mutually desired outcome



Multilevel Nature of Student Participation

• Formal: Governing and Management, Council, Senate, etc.

Quality Assurance: Internal and External

• Student-Centered Learning: Creating ones own learning path
